The Hubs trial program aims to provide coordinated care for people with health conditions that would benefit from a more comprehensive management plan.

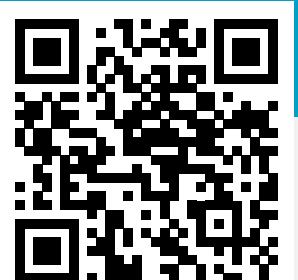
